

# TOWN OF FOYIL ROGERS COUNTY, OKLAHOMA

### ORDINANCE NO. 2023- (

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF FOYIL, OKLAHOMA, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, AMENDING IN ITS ENTIRETY SECTION 1-1, of the Foyil Town Code (2021), TITLED "ELECTIVE OFFICERS OF THE TOWN;" PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; PROVIDING A REPEALER OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND CODE PROVISIONS.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Foyil, Rogers County, Oklahoma, meeting at Town Hall in regular session on this 9<sup>th</sup> day of November 2023, as follows:

Section One (1):

Section 1-1, entitled "Elective officers of the town", of the Foyil Town Code (2021), Town of Foyil, Oklahoma, be amended to read as follows, to-wit:

# **SECTION 1--1 Elective Officers of the Town.**

A. <u>Conduct of Elections</u>: Pursuant to Title 11, Oklahoma Statutes, Section 16-302 as amended, the Town of Foyil, by Ordinance 2023-\_\_\_\_, requires that its officers shall be elected and that initiative and referendum questions shall be decided only through elections conducted by the Rogers County Elections Board, all being pursuant to Oklahoma Statutes Title 11, Section 16-101, et. seq.

- B. <u>Board Members</u>: The board of trustees shall consist of and be composed of five (5) trustees, said trustees to be elected by the town at large. General elections shall be held on the first Tuesday of each odd-numbered year, conducted by the county election board as provided by law. Elections shall be non-partisan and filing periods shall be in accordance with Title 11 Oklahoma Statutes, Sections 16-101, et seq.
- C. <u>Terms</u>: All trustees shall be elected for a term of four (4) years. Their terms shall begin at noon on the second Monday in April after their election. The members shall serve until their respective successors have been elected and qualify.

D. <u>Term-in-office expirations</u>: In 2021, three board members were elected for 2-year terms (Office 1, Office 2 and Office 3) thus ending in 2023, and two board members were elected for 4-year terms (Office 4, and Office 5) thus ending in 2025. Office 1, Office 2 and Office 3 have since been elected to full 4-year terms, thus next ending in 2027.

Section Two (2):

Severability. If any provision, section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or other portion of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held to be unconstitutional, illegal or in conflict, by a Court of competent jurisdiction, or by any federal agency, the remainder of this Ordinance, and the application of such provisions to other persons and circumstances shall not be affected thereby, and to this end, such portion of the Ordinance shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent, provision and not affecting the validity of the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section Three (3):

Effective Date. Following the passage and approval of this Ordinance, same shall be effective as of this 9th day of November 2023.

Section Four (4):

**Repealer.** Any Ordinance or Code provision, or parts thereof, in conflict with this Ordinance are to that extent hereby repealed.

Section Six (5):

The Town Clerk is directed to deliver a true and correct copy of this ordinance to the Rogers County Election Board pursuant to 11 O.S. section 16-302.A.
