**ORDINANCE NO. 2025-1  
AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING  
NOMINATING AND ELECTING  
TRUSTEES AT LARGE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD  
OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF  
FOYIL, OKLAHOMA:

**Section 1.** Pursuant to 11 O.S.  
§12-103.1, nomination and election  
at large of the trustees on the board  
of trustees of the Town of Foyil,  
Rogers County, Oklahoma, is here-  
by authorized.

**Section 2.** After this ordinance be-  
comes effective, the statutory  
requirement that Trustees of the  
Town of Foyil, Rogers County, Ok-  
lahoma, be residents of and  
nominated from wards shall not ap-  
ply.

**Section 3.** This ordinance is in-  
tended to be curative and ratify  
Ordinance 2018-1 with a similar  
purpose which may be questioned  
due to irregularities in adoption.

**Section 4.** This ordinance shall not  
become effective until sixty (60)  
days following the date of its publi-  
cation. Within such sixty-day period,  
the registered voters of the town  
may petition for an election on the  
question of nominating and electing  
the trustees at large in the manner  
provided by law. In such instance,  
this ordinance shall be suspended  
pending the determination of the  
sufficiency of the number of signa-  
tures on the petition or the  
determination of the results of the  
election, if any.
