

Minutes of the Board of Trustees for the Town of Foyil

Regular Meeting

June 11, 2026

Meeting was called to order at 6:00.

Meeting was chaired by Travis Brownlow, Interim Mayor. Trustees present were K. McCombs and R. Heenan. Thecia Ellis, the Town Clerk along with members of the public were also present.

Motion by R. Heenan and seconded by K. McCombs to approve the Regular Meeting Minutes from May 14, 2026 as presented. Motion was approved by roll call vote: T. Brownlow – yes, K. McCombs – yes, R. Heenan – yes.

Motion by T. Brownlow and seconded by K. McCombs to approve the financial statements as presented. Motion was approved by roll call vote: T. Brownlow – yes, K. McCombs – yes, R. Heenan – yes.

Motion by R. Heenan and seconded by K. McCombs to approve the Rogers County Sheriff's Patrol Expenditure Statement for \$1,500 for May 2026 patrols. Motion was approved by roll call vote: T. Brownlow – yes, K. McCombs – yes, R. Heenan – yes.

There were no expenditures not known about prior to the posting of the agenda.

Motion by R. Heenan and seconded by K. McCombs to approve the public hearing regarding the Town of Foyil Budget for 2026-27. Motion was approved by roll call vote: T. Brownlow – yes, K. McCombs – yes, R. Heenan – yes.

Motion by R. Heenan and seconded by T. Brownlow to approve the Public Hearing regarding the Ordinance Violation at 12303 E Oak St. for Public Nuisance, Dilapidated or Burned Structure. Motion was approved by roll call vote: T. Brownlow – yes, K. McCombs – yes, R. Heenan – yes.

Motion by R. Heenan and seconded by K. Mc Combs to approve adding Travis Brownlow to bank accounts ending in 1342, 7528, and 3120. Motion was approved by roll call vote: T. Brownlow – yes, K. McCombs – yes, R. Heenan – yes.

Motion to approve the design and determine the location of the Rt 66 sign. The design was changed to include Totem Pole park instead of the gas station. The motion was tabled until a location was established.

Motion by K. McCombs and seconded by T. Brownlow to approve reimbursement to Thecia Ellis for expenses incurred for travel for the Town of Foyil. Motion was approved by roll call vote: T. Brownlow – yes, K. McCombs – yes, R. Heenan – yes.

Motion by R. Heenan and seconded by T. Brownlow to approve the hosting of Bunko games on the second Sunday of each month. Motion was approved by roll call vote. R. Brownlow – yes, K. McCombs – yes, R. Heenan – yes.

Motion by K. McCombs and seconded by R. Heenan to approve sending Thecia Ellis to the Grant Summit at Rose College on July 9, 2026. Motion was approved by roll call vote: T. Brownlow – yes, K. McCombs – yes, R. Heenan – yes.

Motion by R. Heenan and seconded by K. McCombs to approve having computers in the shed wiped in preparation to sell. The motion was tabled for now until after determining the cost.

Motion by R. Heenan and seconded by K. McCombs to liquidate furniture and other items in the police station. It was determined that we need to complete an inventory of items to sell. Motion was approved by roll call vote: T. Brownlow – yes, K. McCombs – yes, R. Heenan – yes.

Motion by R. Heenan and seconded by T. Brownlow to approve the installation of a Cherokee Nation sign on the outside of the building. Motion was approved by roll call vote: T. Brownlow, K. McCombs – yes, R. Heenan – yes.

Motion by K. McCombs and seconded by T. Brownlow to accept the new bylaws for the Mayor's Council. Motion was approved by roll call vote: T. Brownlow – yes, K. McCombs – yes, R. Heenan – yes.

There were no matters to address that were not known about before the posting of the meeting agenda.

The need to get the mailbox erected for the physical address was discussed for general maintenance, improvements and repairs.

For the Trustee remarks, the board discussed whether to encourage Pam Cyr to rejoin the Board of Trustees. It was also determined that the Town needed to confer with Larry Rahmeier regarding best procedure to facilitate next election for mayor.

In the Call to the Public, Mr. Sislo offered to wipe the computers in the shed for us. Amber Dawn Ellis requested a monument in the park that displayed the 10 Commandments on one side and the Constitution on the other side. It was also discovered that she was will and eligible to join the Board of Trustees.
